BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

This proclamation is to recognize National 4-H Week in October 2025. California 4-H is delivered by the University of California Cooperative Extension, the research and outreach arm of the University of California Agriculture and Natural Resources. The 4-H Youth Development Program of UC ANR and UC Cooperative Extension has a strong presence in San Benito County including dedication to youth development, community service, and lifelong learning.

San Benito County 4-H programs offer valuable opportunities to youth and families, providing real-world skill development guided by an experiential learning model that fosters leadership, responsibility, and community engagement. The youth who engage in 4-H programs learn hands-on skills, which are guided by experimental learning models, to prepare future leaders with real skills for careers that are needed by their local community. Opportunities within 4-H encourage wonder and curiosity for STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) careers while simultaneously boosting graduation rates.

Statistics show that 4-H youth are four times more likely to give back to their community, two times more likely to make healthier choices, and two times more likely to participate in STEM + Ag activities. In San Benito County, over 400 youth have gone through the 4-H "Youth Lab" program, which teaches animal science literacy. Additionally, the 4-H farm on Nash Road in Hollister successfully supported 4 goats, 18

swine, and 1 sheep.

The University of California Cooperative Extension works closely with the San Benito County network of 4-H youth members, volunteers, and leaders to promote outstanding customer service, a strong commitment to continuous learning, and ongoing contributions to the local community.
