BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The community programs division primarily allocates to private non-profit community-based organizations providing services to the most vulnerable individuals and families in San Benito County. Beginning in the Fiscal Year of 2017-2018 (FY 17-18), the Board of Supervisors modified this program. The Board froze the allocation for \$120,000 and segregated it into two (2) sections, including a senior-based program allocation and other non-profits, 80k went to senior services, and 40k was part of a competitive grant before FY 2021-2022. During the recommended budget in FY 21-22, the Board of Supervisors eliminated the grant to other non-profits and allocated a three percent (3%) increase to senior services, and directed further increases to align with the Consumer Price Index in the following years.
