BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The week of July 19-25, 2026, is recognized nationally as Pretrial, Probation, and Parole Supervision Week as sponsored by the American Probation and Parole Association (APPA). This week is recognized by probation departments across California and is known informally as "Probation Services Week".

This proclamation is the first ever of its kind and has not been formally declared in San Benito County in prior years.

The San Benito County Probation Department's mission is to serve the Court and support clients through trauma informed care and rehabilitative services to change behavior and enhance the welfare of the community.

The Probation Department is responsible for the coordination of services to the court and other justice involved partner agencies within the county. These services include assessments, case management, investigations, community supervision, disposition recommendations, service referrals, and treatment of adult clients and youth; written probation reports and recommendations to the court, correctional programming, reentry services; services to victims; and legally mandated court-ordered services. These services are provided in accordance with appropriate sections as designated in the California Rules of Court, Penal Code, Health & Safety Code, Welfare and Institutions Code, Family Code, Civil Code, Code of Civil Procedure, Business & Professions Code, Education Code, Probate Code, and Government Code.

Through utilization of evidence-based practices, the Probation Department promotes public safety, reduces recidivism, and works with victims to mitigate the impact of crime. In collaboration with county partners, probation provides community supervision, accountability, and opportunities for positive change.

The Probation Department is an integral part of the criminal justice system, and the department is comprised of several service divisions: Adult, Juvenile/Investigations (Juvenile and Court Units), Administrative Services, Reentry Services, and the Youth Services Center (formerly Juvenile Hall).

The San Benito County Youth Services Center (YSC) is the primary community resource for justice involved youth. It is part of a system of care that provides a safe, protective, and home-like environment while promoting responsibility, and fostering responsible and accountable behavior for youth through a trauma-informed approach. Our purpose is to promote resiliency while strengthening community connections.

The San Benito County Probation Department is comprised of forty-nine (49) dedicated full-time staff as well as an additional 8-10 extra-help/temporary staff. Probation personnel provide a wide range of essential duties, including supervision, facilitation of rehabilitative programming, coordination of treatment services, supporting victims, supporting the courts, and further promotion of community safety for the public.

This proclamation represents the importance of these probation professionals and recognizes the tremendous contributions that often occur behind the scenes but have a profound impact on public safety and the San Benito County community overall.
