### **BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

On July 1, 2023, the Board of Supervisors authorized a contract for County Counsel services with Prentice/Long PC (Firm) which is due to expire on June 30, 2024. The contract created a "hybrid" county counsel department with the County Counsel and Assistant County Counsels and other attorneys within the firm providing services under the contact while retaining county employed staff within the County Counsel Department. This arrangement allowed for increased services and staffing at the same budget for staffing when county staff costs and contract costs are combined for a total cost of county counsel services.

An analysis of costs reveals that the total cost of the County Counsel Department can be reduced significantly by restructuring the Department to full contract services, eliminating the hybrid model. The

services provided by the firm have proven to be efficient and effective and it is fiscally responsible to employ the contract model. This will require the layoff of county employees and the execution of new expanded scope contract with the Firm.
