BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The Road Ad Hoc Committee has been meeting bi-weekly (on average) and would like to discuss the following status for specific projects:

Frazier Lake Road:

1. Phase I of work occurred on 8/11 & 8/12 for the northerly 2 miles of roadway and included grinding/paving of the roadway asphalt.
2. Phase II of work includes installation of a Cape Seal application for the northerly 2 miles of roadway during the days of 8/21-8/24 from 7am – 5pm.
3. Phase III of work will include a cold-in-place recycling of roadway base and then installation of asphalt pavement. This work will be performed in September along the 1.3 miles of roadway beginning at Shore Road. The exact schedule for the September work is still being finalized.

4. Phase IV of work includes the installation of roadway striping

San Juan Hwy: The contractor is working on a final price/schedule to reconstruct paving adjacent to Anzar High School in San Juan Bautista. The tentative schedule is to perform work in late August/early September.

Union Road: The County is working with one of the on-call consultants to have the design plans ready for bid in mid-September.

Cole Road: The County has received a bid of \$2,595,071.85 and would like to proceed with construction of that project.

Additionally, due to County budget constraints, the Road Ad Hoc recommends a letter for submittal to Assemblyman Robert Rivas and State Senator John Laird requesting their assistance to provide funding for a shovel-ready project. The San Juan Canyon Road Pavement Rehabilitation project was previously identified as a priority for the Board of Supervisors as it provides access to Fremont Peak State Park.
