BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The County of San Benito Migrant Camp Homes is located at 3235 Southside Road, Hollister and consists of thirty-nine (39) duplex homes, a support services office and laundry facilities to a community of seasonal migrant family residents. On December 14th, 2021, the San Benito County Board of Supervisors reviewed and adopted a resolution approving the 2021-2023 Fiscal Year Rehabilitation Grant with the State of California, for the maximum award of \$2,385,000.00 to fund and address a list of priority deferred maintenance items. The Board adopted Architectural plans and specifications for five major scopes (roofs, windows, flooring, interior and exterior paint) and authorized a public contract bid process that concluded with an open bid deadline of June 16th, 2022. The Capital Improvement Project, PWB-2121 was advertised on the County's EbidBoard portal with a project budget of \$1.2M-\$1.8M to allow for the anticipated construction 'soft costs' to keep the project fully within budget of \$2.3M.

Two responsive responsible bidders provided their lowest bid above the Capital Project budget. County Counsel provided guidance in reference to California Public Contract Code section 20150.9 which allows

a determination for the County to reject all bids. If all bids are rejected after the first invitation for bids, after reevaluating its cost estimates, the county shall abandon the project or it may reduce the scope of work and readvertise for bids. If after readvertising, the county again rejects all bids presented, the county may proceed with the project utilizing in-house resources or go back out to another public bid.
