BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Iris Telehealth Medical Group provides outpatient specialty mental health services for Medi-Cal beneficiaries served by San Benito County. Services include psychiatry, intake assessments and reassessment, individual therapy, case management, and collateral. Contractor shall maintain programmatic services offered through the outpatient program.

This amendment is non-monetary and extends the term of the contract by 30 days. The extension is needed to ensure there is proper time for on-boarding and off-boarding of Telepsychiatry providers during the conclusion of the Behavioral Health department's request for proposals for Telepsychiatry Services.

Behavioral Health department issued a Request for Proposals on April 7, 2026. After a fair and comprehensive evaluations a contract was awarded to Bridges Telepsychiatry on June 23, 2026, by the Board of Supervisors. This amendment will allow time for patient care to be transitioned from Iris to Bridges.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This is a non-monetary amendment. There would be no fiscal impact. The total contract amount not to exceed would remain \$1,176,860 for the term of the agreement.

At this point in time a total of \$812,148.70 has been utilized for this agreement.
