Adopt Resolution authorizing retroactive submission of application for and acceptance of the County allocation award under Round 7 of the Transitional Housing Program (THP) in the amount no less than \$113,243.00 and no more than \$226,486.00, and Round 4 of the Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program (HNMP) in the amount no less than \$16,399.00 and no more than \$32,798.00 from the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development for housing assistance for youth formerly in Foster Care or Probation systems, in the combined amount no less than \$129,642.00 and no more than \$259,284.00.

2. Ratify retroactive submission of the Transitional Housing Program (THP) Allocation Acceptance Form and Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program (HNMP) Allocation Acceptance Form, submitted by the Deputy Director of Health and Human Services Agency to the Department of Housing and Community Development.

3. Adopt Budget Amendment Resolution in the amount of \$129,642.00 to increase the State revenue Fund 221 and increase the expenditure appropriation to deliver services and assistance for the THP and HNMP program. (4/5 vote required)

**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

On September 18, 2026, applications were submitted for the THP Round Five 7 allocation for an amount no less than \$113,243.00 but not to exceed \$226,486.00 and the HNMP Round 4 allocation for an

amount no less than \$16,399.00 but not to exceed \$32,798.00. These funds are intended to be used to assist young adults between the ages of eighteen (18) and twenty-four (24) to secure and maintain housing, with priority given to young adults previously in foster care or probation systems.

On October 30, 2025, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) issued an Allocation Acceptance Form, inviting counties to accept the THP Round 7 and the HNMP Round 4 allocations. The award was received on October 30, 2025.

The HNMP program funds housing navigators for counties. The role of housing navigator is to act as a housing specialist to assist young adults with their pursuits of locating available housing and overcoming barriers to locating housing. Housing navigation and maintenance activities may include, but are not limited to:

1. Assist young adults aged 18-24 years of age, inclusive, secure and maintain housing (with priority access given to young adults in the state's foster care system);
2. Provide housing case management which include essential services in emergency supports to foster youth;
3. Prevent young adults from becoming homeless; and
4. Improve coordination of services and linkages to key resources across the community including those from within the child welfare system and the local Continuum of Care.

The THP program funds will be used to help young adults who are 18 to 24 years of age, inclusive, secure and maintain housing with priority given to young adults formerly in the state's foster care or probation systems. Use of THP funds may include, but are not limited to:

1. Identifying and assisting housing services for this population in our community;
2. Assisting this population to secure and maintain housing (with priority given to those in the state's foster care or probation system);
3. Improving coordination of services and linkages to community resources within the child welfare system and the Homeless Continuum of Care; and
4. Providing engagement in outreach and targeting to serve those with the most severe needs.

The County was required to submit the Allocation Acceptance Forms no later than November 08, 2025. Due to short turnaround time between the issuance of the Allocation Acceptance Forms and the submittal deadline, authorization to apply was not able to be requested prior to the deadline. As a result, this is a request to ratify acceptance.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Individual grant amounts:

\* THP Round 7 funds increase in the amount of no less than \$113,243.00 and no more than \$226,486.00.

\* HNMP Round 4 funds increase in the amount of no less than \$16,399.00 and no more than \$32,798.00.

Housing and Community Development recommends using an amount range in the event of additional funding becoming available through redistribution in the future. They recommend dollar amounts to be doubled in the event the county is later awarded more funding that would benefit our youth.

Funding Source is Department of Housing and Community Development.
