BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

This contract allows for the purchase of SLE beds for men, women and perinatal clients of the behavioral health department. This resource allows for a local placement option for clients needing this level of supervision when mandated by our local Child Protective Services as well as mandated to this care level by Probation and the Court system.

This provider differs from residential providers as there is no treatment provided at this location, but this sober living environment is instead used to allow clients to live in a sober space while attending mandated or voluntary treatment via San Benito County Behavioral Health. SLEs provide 24-hour safe, residential housing in a setting that is free from alcohol and other drugs. Most of the referrals to this

provider are through our MOU with probation and CPS to provide a sober living space for individuals receiving mandated treatment. This provider is licensed and is beholden to the California Consortium of Addiction Programs and Professionals (CCAPP) SLE Standards.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Behavioral Health Department issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) on Tuesday March 10, 2026, for qualified Sober Living Environments. The submission deadline was March 31, 2026, by 5 p.m. The department received one submission.

An evaluation panel consisting of the 3 individuals (2 individuals outside of the county, and one department employee) evaluated the proposal based on the evaluation matrix provided in the RFP. Sun Street Center received a score of 93.07%. out of 100%.

The evaluation panel awarded this score as the proposal demonstrated that their agency has the necessary qualifications, regulatory compliance and a strong record of effective service delivery. Sun Street Centers possesses extensive experience providing outpatient treatment, sober living environments (SLEs), and residential services. Their proposal reflects a well established operational history in delivering comparable services across multiple California counties, demonstrating both organizational stability and the capacity to successfully meet program requirements. The agency maintains active registration with the California Consortium of Addiction Programs and Professionals (CCAPP), ensuring compliance with professional standards and credentialing expectations. Given their experience, regulatory compliance, proven service outcomes, and organizational capacity, Sun Street Centers is determined to be the most responsive and qualified proposer.

Accordingly, they are recommended for award of the final contract. This is a 3-year term, fee for service contract to Sun Street Center with a contract total not to exceed \$300,000 for the term of the agreement. The proposal and contract provide a bed day rate of \$57.31 This will allow the County to provide 1744 bed days per fiscal year. This contract is paid out of the non-general fund to GL # 230.90.2540.1000.630.116.
