**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

Valley Health Associates has been a San Benito County Behavioral Health Department community partner since 2019. For the past 6 years their organization has provided County residents medicated assisted treatment services for substance use disorders, specifically their Narcotic Treatment Program. However, clients must travel to Monterey County to receive this proven evidence-based treatment option.

By providing a location for Valley Health Associates to utilize their mobile unit on site at the Behavioral Health Clinic it will significantly improve the accessibility and convenience for clients to participate in medicated assisted treatment.

Valley Health Associates have been a key partner in helping the Behavioral Health department address the opioid and stimulant epidemic through the comprehensive substance use disorder programs. Their commitment to helping San Benito County provide accessible treatment options has made a significant impact on the lives of our community members.

Behavioral Health currently treats on average 18 clients through Valley Health Associates medicated assisted treatment programs.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no fiscal impact as this is a non-monetary memorandum of understanding. The execution of this agreement will only benefit the community as it is an expansion of medicated assisted treatment for Narcotic Treatment Program behavioral health services provided in San Benito County.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Approve the non-monetary Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Valley Health Associates (VHA) to allow VHA to park their mobile unit at the San Benito County Behavioral Health (SBCBH) clinic site to provide Medicated Assisted Treatment services for substance use disorder clients in San Benito County; and
2. Authorize the Board Chair to sign said agreement. There is no financial component to this agreement.
