BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), through the 1915 B waiver process with the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medi-Caid Services, requires local county Mental Health Plans to provide an array of services for Medi-Cal beneficiaries. These include inpatient, residential, and intensive outpatient services to address a variety of conditions. The inpatient and outpatient facilities normally contracted with by the Behavioral Health Department do not always address the specialized needs that a client may require. This requires the San Benito County Behavioral Health to enter into single case agreements, often at a very accelerated timeline, to ensure both the psychiatric, and medical components are addressed in a crisis situation.

San Benito County Behavioral Health is requesting approval of the Resolution of the Board of Supervisors Authorizing Single Case Agreement Approval for Continuity of Care in Mental Health Services. In December 2019, the California Department of Health Care Services ("DHCS") issued Mental health and Substance Use Disorder Services ("MHSUDS") Information Notice No 18-059, setting forth

continuity of care requirements for Medi-Cal beneficiaries who receive specialty mental health services from County Mental Health Plans. The Single Case Agreement for Continuity of Care will fulfill the requirements of the DHCS Information Notice, allowing the County to process requests within the timeframes provided (from 3 to 30 calendar days).
