BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

A&A Health Services (AAHS) provides Residential Group Home board and care services for older adults who have severe and/or debilitating mental illness. A&A can house individuals from our community that may typically be categorized as hard to place due to age and their chronic medical conditions. Individuals who are placed with AAHS are done so under Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) conservatorship with San Benito County Behavioral Health because they do not have a responsible significant other or family member who can provide the assistance they require. When LPS conserved clients are placed in residential facilities, the client's assets are used to cover the costs associated with placement, and any remainder amount is the responsibility of the County Behavioral Health Department.

AAHS provides services that are mandated by the Department of Health Care Services. The number of

beneficiaries that utilize these services within San Benito County is low (4 clients in fiscal years 2024-2026). Finding contractors is difficult therefore when SBCBH finds one willing to be a provider for this specialized service SBCBH generates a contract that will allow the department and county to utilize their facilities when the need arises.

The main justification for seeking sole source with AAHS is due to timelines and the need for continuity of care. SBCBH will be going through an RFP process in FY26/27 and have a continuation of the available contracts will allow us time to RFP.

FISCAL IMPACT:

San Benito County Behavioral Health has contracted with AAHS since December 2021.

- FY 24-26 with contract budget \$440,000 with an amendment signed by the Board Chair on 5/7/24 which increased the not-to-exceed amount to \$500,000
- FY 23-24 with contract budget \$220,000
- FY 22-23 with contract budget \$220,000
- FY 21-22 (12/1/21 - 6/30/22) with contract budget \$49,999
