**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

Behavioral Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission (BHSOAC), formerly Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission (MHSOAC), oversees the implementation of the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) and one of their responsibilities is to distribute grants such as the Mental Health Student Services Act (MHSSA). The MHSSA is to establish additional mental health partnerships between county behavioral health departments and local education entities to increase services to students and their families. San Benito County Behavioral Health receives the grant on behalf of San Benito County Office of Education, and then SBCBH transfers the funding to SBCOE. Over the past few years, SBCBH and SBCOE have built and developed a more robust school-based mental health infrastructure on several school campuses including mental health providers, wellness centers, parent &

community education, wellbeing outreach.

This Amendment will expand the term of the funds to enable San Benito County Behavioral Health and San Benito County Office of Education to continue to work together on school-based mental health services for students and parents through December 30, 2028. The Amendment also reflects changes made to Exhibits A & B from the original Standard Agreement which include the addition of a final report as well as modifications to the grant funding schedule.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The original Standard Agreement was approved by the Board on February 2, 2025. This Amendment extends the original end date for another year from December 31, 2027 to December 31, 2028. The general ledger # is 228.90.2520.1000.224.
