BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

On November 12, 2024, the Board of Supervisors adopted the official meeting calendar for 2025. Since that time, staff has identified the need to schedule a Public Hearing on December 9, 2025 to consider the Implementation of the 6th Cycle Housing Element Program 3-2 Residential High Rezone and General Plan Amendment, including related amendments to San Benito County Code Title 25 (Zoning) and Title 23 (Subdivision).

Because the adopted calendar does not currently include a Regular Meeting on December 9, 2025, staff recommends amending the calendar to add this meeting date. This amendment is necessary to ensure that the Public Hearing can be properly noticed, conducted, and deliberated by the Board in compliance with statutory requirements and to maintain the County's progress on Housing Element implementation.
