Approve retroactive Amendment No. 1 with Evolve Adolescent Behavioral Health for a court ordered 30-day extension of emergency residential treatment for a client of San Benito County Behavioral Health single case agreement for an additional \$44,000.00 and a total contract not to exceed amount for \$99,000.00 for the term of February 19, 2026, through April 24, 2026; and

2. Authorize Board chair, County Executive Officer, or designee to sign said agreement.

**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

In February 2026, San Benito County Behavioral Health received notice from San Benito County Probation that a youth client was in crisis and required emergency placement in a residential facility. A court hearing was held that determined the only facility that offered the required treatment model for co-occurring treatment the client required was Evolve Adolescent Behavioral Health. This agency is not a Medi-Cal provider. Staff negotiated rate of \$1,7000 per day for a 30 day stay. Evolve Adolescent notified probation the client needed an extension of treatment. Additional court hearings were held on March 23rd and April 2 in which the court ordered the client to receive the maximum 60 days of treatment. The additional 30 days will be charged at a reduced rate of \$1,600 per day.

If Behavioral Health does not have an active contract with the provider, the client could lose their spot at the treatment facility. As previously mentioned, this is a court order for treatment at this specific facility, so it is imperative an amendment to the original single case agreement is signed as soon as possible to

ensure County is not in violation of the court order.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Per state mandates and court orders San Benito County Behavioral Health is required to finance up to 60 days of emergency care for a client in crisis. Funding for this placement will come from the Behavioral Health department's realignment funds which supports inpatient and/or residential placements. Total agreement is not to exceed \$99,000 for the term of February 19 through April 24, 2026.

Original single case agreement: \$51,000 (30 day stay).  
Amendment Number 1: \$44,000 (30 day stay).
