BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

In May of 2025 the San Benito County Board of Supervisors directed the Behavioral Health Department to issue a formal Request for Proposals (RFP) in accordance with the County's new purchasing policy for the behavioral health clinics private security vendor. In general, all health facilities require on-site security during the clinic's operational hours. It was determined that the security contract met a new threshold and to ensure a competitive solicitation process an RFP was required. The Board of Supervisors requested that the Behavioral Health Board be included in the RFP process and requested the Behavioral Health Board to make a formal recommendation to the Board of Supervisors after the RFP process was completed.

On September 1, 2025, the Behavioral Health Department issued an RFP for a private security provider through the OpenGov. platform. The department held a pre-proposal conference on September 9th,

issued an FQA on September 16th and ended the solicitation process on September 19, 2025.

A total of 13 applications were received. The Behavioral Health Department was able to obtain a quorum of Behavioral Health Board members to complete the RFP evaluation. On November 20, 2025 at their regular meeting, the Behavioral Health Board reviewed and discussed all 13 applications.

The applicants were evaluated on: 1) meeting state qualifications, 2) behavioral health industry trainings, 3) experience and capacity, and 4) cost. Full description of the evaluation criteria can be found in attachment 1.

SBCBH’s Behavioral Health Board members ultimately selected to recommend Regency Security Group.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Behavioral Health Department has had one previous private security contract for the FY 24-25 with a different vendor. The previous contract was a fee for service agreement that paid a total of \$130,522.50 for the FY 24-25. There have been two amendments to the original contract. Amendment No. 1 extended the term of the agreement. Amendment No. 2 extended the term of the agreement to 12/31/25 and also added additional funding (\$59,000) to the contract total not to exceed \$225,400.

All funds will be from non-general fund. Cost allocation will be an 80/20 split between Mental Health Services and Substance Use Disorder Services funding streams (GL 228.90.2520.1000.619.224 and

230.90.2540.1000.619.224).
