**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

The County of San Benito has been selected for an award of \$1,911,246.00 for the 2023/2024 CDBG-DR Infrastructure (DR-INF) Program and an additional award of \$9,563,290.00 for the 2023/2024 Mitigation Resilient Infrastructure & Planning Program. Those awards are related to the large storm events that occurred during 2023. These CDBG-DR funds are allocated by HUD to help cities, counties, Indian tribes, and States recover from Presidentially declared disasters to help focus on long-term recovery efforts. Additional program details can be found in the attached agenda item- Housing and Community Development "(HCD) Program Information".

Projects that utilize these funds must be completed by the second quarter of 2030. The funds allocated to San Benito County are approximately \$11.4 million, however, HCD has noted that similar programs often have unexpended funds. Consequently, HCD encourages agencies to create project lists that might utilize potential unexpended funds. Consequently, the County of San Benito will consider passing a resolution for these programs in the amount of \$17 million.

Staff has held meetings with HCD and internal staff and will provide a summary of the program and

potential projects. Per direction from the Board of Supervisors, staff will submit project applications to HCD for approval. Final project applications must be submitted to HCD for approval by February 28, 2026.

The County of San Benito has also been selected for an award of \$7,625,616.00 for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program. This includes funding for:

- **Implementation funding:** \$7,425,616.00
- **Supplemental planning and demonstration activity funding (if applicable):** \$200,000.00 for Supplemental Planning.

**Next Steps:** The United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) and San Benito County must establish and execute a signed, mutually agreed upon grant agreement prior to the obligation of award funds. Staff will provide a very brief summary of this award. Additional details will be provided at a future Board of Supervisor meeting.
