BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

In 2023, San Benito County Public Health Services received Board of Supervisors approval to accept funding through the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) California Home Visiting Program (CHVP). This program is housed within the Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health (MCAH) Program and represents an expansion of existing MCAH services funded through the Title V MCAH Block Grant to include a home visiting component.

At that time, CDPH released an Agreement Funding Application (AFA) with a five-year funding cycle (FY 2023–2028). San Benito County Public Health Services applied and was awarded \$442,702 annually for the duration of the agreement, supporting program implementation and staffing, including a 1.0 FTE

Public Health position to carry out home visiting services.

CDPH has since transitioned CHVP funding to a three-year agreement cycle and has released a new Agreement Funding Application (AFA) for FY 2026–2029. Although the original award remains in effect through FY 2027–2028, the updated AFA extends the funding period through FY 2028–2029 to align with CDPH's revised funding structure.

Approval is now being requested to accept the extension of CHVP funding and associated agreement update in order to continue program services without interruption and maintain alignment with CDPH requirements.
