BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The Sunnyslope County Water District ("SCWD" or "District") is required to adopt a Conflict of Interest Code pursuant to the Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 87300 et seq.). As a local agency within the County of San Benito, the District's Conflict of Interest Code is subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors, acting as the code reviewing body under Government Code Section 87303.

On June 24, 2025, the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District adopted a resolution amending the District's Conflict of Interest Code to reflect the required biennial review and any necessary updates to designated positions and disclosure categories. A copy of the District's resolution and the amended Conflict of Interest Code are attached to this staff report.

Approval of this item will fulfill the Board of Supervisors' role as the code reviewing body for the District's amended Conflict of Interest Code. Upon approval, the County Clerk will notify the Sunnyslope County Water District of the action taken.
