BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The Chair will delegate the assignments of RCRC, GSFA, GSCA, and CSAC for the year 2026 at this meeting as these boards and commissions have meetings the week of January 19th, 2026, prior to the next available Board meeting. (CSCA, GSCA, and ESJPA are affiliated with RCRC and hold the same appointment as RCRC)

The Chair may also assign the remaining boards and commissions at this meeting or the chair may designate and appoint the remaining board commissions, standing committees, and ad hocs at a later date. The remaining 2025 Ad Hocs are attached. If there is a continuing need for a committee, they

should be reappointed. If a committee is desired to be instituted as a long-term or permanent committee with an established jurisdiction over a certain subject, staff will evaluate their formation as a standing committee.

At its meeting on September 23, 2025, the Board of Supervisors considered a recommendation from the Tourism Advisory Committee regarding the establishment of a Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) Incentive Program.

Following discussion, the Board directed the formation of an ad hoc committee to conduct a comprehensive review of the proposed program. The committee's scope of work will include:

- Evaluation of the Transient Occupancy Tax Incentive Program in its entirety.
- Assessment of boutique hotel size parameters to determine appropriate thresholds for eligibility.
- Review of the \$10 million renovation threshold, including its applicability and potential impacts on local development.
- Examination of the renovation provisions as a whole, ensuring alignment with broader economic and tourism objectives.

Supervisors Zanger and Curro were appointed to serve on the ad hoc committee and will report back to the Board with findings and recommendations.
