**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

National Philanthropy Day, celebrated annually in November, is a nationally recognized day set aside to honor the contributions of individuals, organizations, and businesses that engage in philanthropy, defined broadly as the giving of time, talent, or financial resources for the common good. Officially designated by a proclamation from President Ronald Reagan in 1986, National Philanthropy Day highlights the profound impact that generosity and civic engagement have on local communities across the country.

In San Benito County, philanthropy plays a critical role in enhancing the wellbeing of residents and supporting the region's nonprofit sector. Each year, the Community Foundation for San Benito County invites local jurisdictions to join in recognizing this day to elevate the visibility of charitable efforts and to encourage continued support for local causes.

The Community Foundation works year-round to promote a culture of giving, connect donors with community needs, and support nonprofit organizations throughout the county. By recognizing National Philanthropy Day, the County and cities demonstrate their support for the values of compassion, generosity, and community service.

Issuing a proclamation for National Philanthropy Day on November 6, 2025, aligns with the County's commitments to fostering a strong, connected, and resilient community.
