BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The San Benito County Mosquito Abatement Program was established in 2007 as a department within the San Benito County Agricultural Commissioner's Office. By Resolution No. 2007-65 the San Benito County Board of Supervisors is authorized to levy assessments to provide Mosquito Abatement and Disease Control Services. The Preliminarily Engineer's Report for the County Mosquito Abatement program is prepared annually and determines the assessment rate needed to fund this program. FY 25/26 the assessment was raised from \$11.22 to \$15.78 per unit.

For the upcoming fiscal year, the Engineer's Report is recommending that the assessment remain at \$15.78 per single family equivalent (SFE). The 2026-27 CPI is 3.0365%; however, the maximum applied in a single year is 3.00%. The CPI adjustment schedule allows any unused CPI from prior years to accumulate and be used in subsequent years. The maximum authorized assessment rate allowed for FY 2026/2027 would be \$16.24 per SFE; however, the proposed rate to be levied is \$15.78 per SFE. After discussion, the Board may elect to pass a resolution of intent to levy the assessment for FY

2026/2027, preliminarily accept the Engineer's Report, and schedule a Public Hearing. The projected revenue and expenses have been budgeted in the Mosquito Abatement Program Proposed Budget for FY 2026/20267.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The anticipated revenue and expenses have been budgeted in the Mosquito Abatement Program Proposed Budget for FY 2026/2027.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:
