**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

The California Department of Health Care Services ( DHCS) administers the Behavioral Health Services Act, Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) Act, Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness (PATH), Community Mental Health Services Block Grant (MHBG), Substance Use Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery Services Block Grant (SUBG), and Crisis Counseling Assistance and Training Program (CCP), and oversees county provision of community mental health services pursuant to the Bronzan-McCorquodale Act.

San Benito County Behavioral Health Department must meet certain conditions and requirements to receive funding for these programs and services, as set forth in this County Performance Contract, as

required by Welfare and Institutions Code (W&I) sections 5650(a), 5651, and 5897.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This agreement outlines the terms and conditions the San Benito County Behavioral Health Department must meet in order to receive the necessary funding from the Department of Health Care Services that allows the department to operate.
