BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Rebekah Children's Services was one of two providers awarded the request for proposal (RFP BH23-002) for Outpatient youth services in 2023. Contractor assists the department with outpatient services for Child & Transitional Age Youth (TAY) population of San Benito County. The RFP BH23- 002 was introduced in February of 2023 to work collaboratively with Community Based Organizations to ensure services were available to community members that benefit from Behavioral Health services. It allows more community members to benefit from the services provided by the Contractor in the ages ranging between 5 through 25. With the first and second amendments, they enabled the contractor to expand their services in the county by providing Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS), Family Urgent Response Services (FURS), and case management services on behalf of San Benito County Behavioral Health.

This third amendment is to enable the Contractor to bill SBCBH appropriately for services based on the rates that the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) provides every year. The information in the "Financial Information and Schedules - Provider Rate Table" doesn't reflect the annual rates provided by DHCS. The third amendment replaces the table with a more accurate statement about service rates.

FISCAL IMPACT:

- This will be the third amendment to the initial contract with the Contractor.
- The original contract was signed in 7/25/2023 by the Board Chair.
- The first amendment (signed on 2/27/2024 by the Board Chair) updated the original contract to include FURS and TBS services along with an updated provider rate schedule and pass through rates. It did not change the term or budget.
- The second amendment (signed on 8/23/2024 by the Deputy CAO) modified the scope of work by adding case management services. It did not change the term or budget.
- The contract budget remains the same since the initial contract at \$2,489,997.
- The actual costs per fiscal year since January 1, 2024 are:
 - 1/1/24-6/30/24 – \$501,102.73
 - 7/1/24-6/30/25 – \$417,085.76
