BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Now in its fifth year, Operation Green Light is spearheaded by NACo and the National Association of County Veterans Service Officers, building upon successful efforts by the New York State Association of Counties and the NYS County Veteran Service Officers' Association in 2021. In 2023 and 2024, over 450 counties participated in Operation Green Light.

Operation Green Light is an initiative led by NACo and the National Association of County Veterans Service Officers, built upon efforts by the New York State Association of Counties and the NYS County Veteran Service Officers Association, who originated this work in 2021. Operation Green Light intends to honor our nation's veterans and to raise awareness of the role that counties play in providing vital

services to veterans. Once again, this Veterans Day, the National Association of Counties (NACo) and the National Association of County Veterans Service Officers (NACVSO) invite the nation's 3,069 counties, parishes, and boroughs to join Operation Green Light and show support for veterans by lighting our buildings green from November 4-11, 2025.

San Benito County residents, businesses, and community organizations are encouraged to participate in Operation Green Light by changing one light to a green bulb. By shining a green light, we let our veterans know that they are seen, appreciated, and supported.

The County maintenance team will light up the County Administration Building and the Office of Emergency Services from November 4 to November 11 to participate in Operation Green Lights.
