**Background:** In Dunedin, Cooper served on numerous volunteer advisory

committees and was the creator and host for a weekly cable television program on local government and community events. When the City of Dunedin established its 24/7 government cable

TV channel in 2003, the Commission named its City Hall

production facility as "The Gus Cooper Studio" in recognition for his participation in more than 600 TV programs over a 22-year

period.

Other community activities included: Dunedin Country Club director from 1981-85 (DCC president from 1983-84); member of the Board of Trustees of Mease Manor, a 500-unit retirement facility (1983-2001); member of the Rotary Club of Dunedin; director of the Dunedin Historical Society and editor of its newsletter; community advisory boards for the Junior League of Clearwater/Dunedin and Schiller International University; and was

Clearwater/Dunedin and Schiller International University; and wa a two-term president of the Dunedin Council of Organizations

(1989-90).
