Background:

In accordance with a recent request by Mayor Bujalski, conveyed by Whit Blanton (Forward Pinellas), FDOT District VII Secretary, David Gwynn, will provide an update to the City Commission regarding temporary safety measures being considered for implementation at the Skinner Blvd (SR 580) & Pinellas Trail Crossing; followed by an opportunity for questions and discussion.

Secretary Gwynn will discuss ongoing coordination efforts between FDOT, Forward Pinellas, Pinellas County, and the City of Dunedin in order to address safety concerns at this intersection.
