Background: The National Trust for Historic Preservation established May as

Historic Preservation Month. This designation was established in 1973 as a way to promote historic places to instill national and community pride., advocate heritage tourism, and show the social

and economic benefits of historic preservation.

The City of Dunedin adopted its Historic Preservation Ordinance

in 2018. Since the adoption of the Ordinance, the City is recognized as a Certified Local Government by the State of Florida's Department of State, locally designated 25 properties as

historic landmarks, and completed all three phases of the

Citywide Historic Resources Survey.

The proclamation states the City's continued commitment in historic preservation to help maintain the unique identity and character of this community in celebrating May as Historic

Preservation Month.
