Background: The FY 2019 Adopted Budget set aside \$10,000 in Account

#001-1400-511.82-01 for funding requests that come in throughout the year

and would be considered outside the City of Dunedin Aid to Private Organizations application process. Four post FY 2019 Budget Adoption funding requests previously approved for a total of \$9,300, reduced the available set aside amount to \$700. The funding level approved by this action (\$500 being recommended) would further reduce the set aside portion in FY 2019 Adopted Budget.

The Dunedin High School Boys Baseball Booster has submitted a funding request of \$500, to go towards food and drinks for the State Championship in Fort Myers, Florida. The total projected costs for food and drinks for two days for 30 people (24 boys plus coaches) is approximately \$1,500. The County is paying for the Hotel and the Bus transportation costs to Fort Meyers. The boys left for the tournament on May 30th.

TEAM STATISTICS

The team record in 2019 is 22 wins and 8 losses. They are 2019 district champions as well as the 2019 regional champions. Team is #1 in Pinellas County for the highest team GPA, and was in the top five in the state for a team GPA. The team consists of 10 seniors- 8 of which are playing next level college baseball via scholarships.

On May 30, 2019 the subcommittee met to consider the funding request. The detail of request and resulting recommendation is listed below:

Requestor: Dunedin High Boys Baseball Booster

Requested Amount: \$500

Intended Use: Funding will be use to cover food and drinks for 30

people associated with travel to State Championship.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Funding a Cash Grant of \$500

The Toronto Blue Jays have offered to also contribute \$500 to the Dunedin High School Baseball Booster as a match to that of the City's.
