Subject: FY27 Temporary Road Closure Blanket List - October 2026 through July 2027

Staff Recommendation: Commission approval of the FY27 Temporary Road Closure Blanket List for October 2026 through July 2027

Strategic Themes: Community Amentities

Boards & Committees: Community Redevelopment Agency

Budget Impact: All road closure expenses incurred from privately conducted events shall be paid for by event promoters.

Past Action: The Temporary Road Closure Blanket List request is submitted annually as a streamlined operational practice, consolidating all closures for Commission approval at one time, rather than individually. This approach secures advanced authorization for the upcoming fiscal year's events.

Next Action: Staff will coordinate corresponding Special Event Road closures and related logistics.

Background: Several Special Events throughout the year, including private, co-sponsored, or City of Dunedin produced events, require temporary road closures and must be approved annually by the Commission. In some cases, closures involve portions of County or State roads, requiring additional permitting and approval from the appropriate jurisdictional agencies, such as Pinellas County or the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). These agencies may request confirmation of prior Commission approval to support their decision-making and ensure alignment.

All road closures are coordinated in consultation with the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) and the City of Dunedin Public Services Division's Traffic Section.

As such, staff hereby recommends Commission approval of the attached "FY27 Temporary Road Closure Blanket List, for October 2026 through September 2027", as detailed herein.
