Background:

The City of Dunedin operates the Dunedin Marina, a public marina facility which includes a boat dock used for ferry operations. The ferry dock sustained damage in 2024 from Hurricanes Helene and Milton, resulting in the disruption of ferry services in and out of the Dunedin Marina. The necessary repair and restoration of the ferry dock requires the installation of pilings to ensure structural integrity and safe operation of ferry vessels, as further described in Exhibit A - Interlocal Agreement.

Clearwater has the expertise, equipment, and personnel necessary to perform these repairs / restoration services. The City of Dunedin desires to engage Clearwater to perform these services in a timely and efficient manner to restore ferry operations. The City of Clearwater has indicated a willingness and ability to provide these services under the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

As such, staff hereby recommends Commission approval to enter into an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Dunedin and the City of Clearwater for assistance with repairs to the Ferry Landing / Dock at the Dunedin Marina, by Clearwater staff, as detailed herein.
