Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the Restated Coastal Route Funding Agreement with the Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority (PSTA for the Jolley Trolley)

Strategic Themes: Multi-Modal Transit

Budget Impact: The Coastal Route Agreement funds are budgeted in the Community Redevelopment Agency (\$38,700) and the Economic Development Department General Fund (\$25,800) for FY 2026, for a total of \$64,500. The agreement cost in FY 2026 is \$63,911.

Past Action: The Jolley Trolley Service Agreement between Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority, and the City of Dunedin was first initiated on December 22, 2010. The Coastal Route Funding Agreement for the Jolley Trolley was renewed on July 26, 2016, was amended on September 1, 2017, a Second Amendment became effective on October 1, 2018 and the Renewed and Restated Agreement became effective on September 9, 2022.
