Background:

The South Dunedin Character Overlay is proposed to assist in implementing the goals, objectives, and policies in the Dunedin Comprehensive Plan pertaining to the protection of the character of existing neighborhoods and to ensure development and redevelopment that is compatible with the surrounding land and land uses.

The intent is to establish this character overlay with the intent of ensuring compatibility as defined by the Dunedin Comprehensive Plan. It is anticipated that this overlay will promote development and redevelopment that will lead to the continuation, conservation and improvement that complements the scale and physical character of the original buildings located in this area. This will lead to increased property value and encouraging rehabilitation and reuse as opposed to demolition. The overlay will further protect neighborhoods that have significant architectural and historic merit and a distinct character but do not qualify for, or have not yet received, historic designation.

The presentation to the City Commission will consist of a City staff presentation followed by a consultant presentation.
