Background: In 1966, the Dunedin High School Falcons boys'™ basketball team coached by Frank L. Griffin won the state championship, their first and only time to do so. Coach Griffin won Florida High School Coach of the Year in 1966 - the championship year. In his seven years at Dunedin High, the boys'™ basketball team never had a losing season and won more than 200 games. Coach Griffin passed away in 2001. In February 2025, Dunedin High School honored his memory and the state championship victory by naming their gym, "Frank L. Griffin Athletic Center."
