**Background:** Resolution 26-05 was approved on March 19, 2026, establishing the Golf Club Advisory Committee. The Committee shall be advisory to the City Commission and to the City Manager and his or her staff. The primary duties of the Committee shall be to advise the City Commission in the operation of the Dunedin Golf Club as a self-sufficient enterprise. The Committee shall consist of seven regular members and two alternate members. At no time shall there be more than three members of the Dunedin Golf Club on the Committee and the Committee is encouraged to have one member of the Board of Finance. Members should be individuals with general business experience and knowledge of golf, and citizens who represent the interests of the community in general. The initial appointments to the Committee shall be four members for three years; two

members for two years; and one member for one year. All subsequent appointments shall be for three year terms.

The window for initial membership applications to be received was March 23, 2026 - April 6, 2026 with a total of 42 applications received from Dunedin residents, 17 of which are Dunedin Golf Club members.

At the April 15, 2026, Board of Finance meeting, the Board recommended Al Crossman to serve as the BOF regular member.
