In order to qualify for this advanced certificate, officers must meet a set of criteria. Candidates must hold a valid General Law Enforcement Certification, ensuring a foundation in law enforcement principles. Additionally, they must accumulate a required number of points, which are awarded for a combination of formal education, specialized law enforcement training programs, and documented experience as a sworn law enforcement officer. These requirements are designed to recognize those who have demonstrated advanced knowledge, skills, and significant experience in the law enforcement profession.
