beer) and waiving of festival permit fees associated with the 100th Torras Causeway celebration to be held at Gascoigne Bluff Park on

July 13, 2024 (L. Gurganus)

BACKGROUND: A special committee comprised of community leaders from Glynn

County, the City of Brunswick, the Brunswick Golden Isles Chamber of Commerce, the Golden Isles Convention and Visitors Bureau, St.

Simons Land Trust, Keep Golden Isles Beautiful, Sea Island

Foundation, and Torras Properties Inc. is planning a special event to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the opening of the Torras Causeway. The event will be held on Saturday, July 13, 2024. The festivities will begin in Brunswick and conclude at Gascoigne Bluff Park on St. Simons Island. Activities planned at the park include an artists market, lunch, entertainment, beer garden, an interpretive

storytime, and burying of a time capsule.

The Torras Properties Inc., as the primary event sponsor, is seeking Board of Commissioners approval to serve and sell alcoholic beverages (wine and beer) at the celebration. Since the event is being coordinated with the support of Glynn County Board of Commissioners, staff is also seeking BOC approval to waive festival permit fees associated with hosting the event at Gascoigne Park.
