**AGENDA LANGUAGE:** Accept the FEMA-4738-DR-GA Hurricane Idalia Post Disaster Recipient – Sub recipient Agreement and authorize replenishment of the General Fund Committed Fund Balance to Revenue Stabilization Fund as reimbursements are received. (M. Hardin) (FC Vote: 3-0)

**BACKGROUND:** Accept the FEMA-4738-DR-GA Hurricane Idalia Post Disaster Recipient – Sub recipient Agreement. This agreement allows FEMA to allocate funding to reimburse Glynn County for some of the funds expended during Hurricane Idalia. As reimbursements are received, the General Fund Committed Fund Balance for the Revenue Stabilization Funds will be replenished. Glynn County was declared to be in a State of Emergency due to Hurricane Irma on August 29, 2023. Due to the severity of the storm and its devastating effects, that same month President Biden issued a Presidential Disaster Declaration, FEMA-4738-DR-GA to help local units of government with federal financial assistance. Glynn County incurred approximately \$583,266 in reimbursement eligible costs related to Hurricane Idalia. We anticipate approximate FEMA reimbursements of 75% totaling \$437,450 and GEMA reimbursements of 12.5% totaling \$72,908, for a total reimbursement of \$510,358 and a County responsibility 12.5% totaling \$72,908.
