AGENDA LANGUAGE: Seaboard Inert Landfill - Hold a public hearing regarding Seaboard Construction Company's application to the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) for a permit to operate a Private Inert Landfill at 7600 Golden Isles Parkway, Brunswick, 31525. The purpose of the hearing is to collect comments to forward to the EPD; the Board of Commissioners does not vote on the application. (S. Leif)

BACKGROUND: Hold a public hearing regarding Seaboard Construction Company's application to the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) for a permit to operate a Private Inert Landfill at 7600 Golden Isles Parkway, Brunswick, 31525. Information on the application is available on the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division, [website](#).

The purpose of the hearing is to collect comments to forward to the EPD; the Board of Commissioners does not vote on the application.

The agent, Thomas & Hutton, representing the applicant for the EPD permit will be present at the hearing to provide an overview of the project. They submitted the below summary:

"The proposed project will be an approximately 10.5 acre Inert Landfill located on parcel number 03-27018 off Golden Isles

Parkway. The proposed Inert Landfill project is compliant with the current "Glynn County Solid Waste Management Plan" and has been reviewed as part of the Coastal Regional Commission of Georgia DRI process. The operations for this project include disposal of inert waste such as concrete, cured asphalt, rock, bricks, limbs, roots, and additional organic materials related to horizontal construction. Access to the site is gated and will be used privately by Seaboard Construction Company. The site is currently being used as a Borrow Pit so no additional traffic volume will be generated due to the operation of the Inert Landfill."
