**AGENDA LANGUAGE:** Approve the second-year renewal option for Debris Removal and Disposal Services with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. (D. Smith) (FC Vote: 3-0)

**BACKGROUND:** Glynn County selected Ceres Environmental Services, Inc for debris removal and disposal services via the RFP process in 2022 (RFP#22039). The awarded contract provides for four optional one-year extensions. This request is to issue the second one-year extension for Ceres Environmental to provide debris removal and disposal services. There is a 5% increase in unit pricing that was submitted for the second-year pricing as part of the original RFP submittal. All other terms and conditions of the referenced RFP remain unchanged and are included in this extension to the same extent as if set out here in full.

This is an as needed service to be utilized following tropical storm events for debris removal and disposal. There is not funding associated with this contract until activated for debris removal and disposal.

Staff is seeking BOC approval to exercise the second-year renewal option to extend the agreement with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc through June 30th, 2025.

2. Do not exercise the second-year option and direct staff to issue an RFP for this service.
