**AGENDA LANGUAGE:** Authorize the issuance of a purchase order to Temple, Inc. for the procurement of eleven (11) uninterruptible auxiliary power supply and rack kits and eleven (11) preformed cabinet bases in the amount of \$73,865 utilizing a single source exemption in order to keep the product consistent with what was previously installed in our signalized intersections with funding to be provided by the FY26 Multi-Year Capital Projects Fund. (A. Vicent) (FC 3-0)

**BACKGROUND:** Public Works is requesting approval to issue a purchase order utilizing a single source exemption for the procurement of eleven (11) uninterruptible auxiliary power supply and rack kits and eleven (11) preformed cabinet bases from Temple, Inc. Eleven (11) uninterruptible auxiliary power supplies were installed in eleven (11) signalized intersections in FY25. We are asking for a single source exemption in order to keep these products consistent with what has been installed previously.

These power supplies and bases will be fitted to 11 of the 34 signals that Glynn County owns, operates, and maintains. The battery-powered uninterruptible power supply units will allow traffic signals at these intersections to remain operational during electrical power loss, which is the most common reason traffic signals go "dark"—especially during tropical weather events. The current 5-year capital plan provides for multiyear funding to procure and install auxiliary

backup power units and bases on all 34 Glynn County signals. County staff will complete the installation of these units upon receipt of the parts from Temple, Inc. Funding for these units and bases is provided in the FY26 Multi-Year Capital Projects Fund. This purchase and project does not include signals.
