AGENDA LANGUAGE:	Approve the purchase and subsequent maintenance and repair agreement with Georgia Power for the replacement and maintenance of High Mast Interchange Lighting at Exit 42 at Highway 99, in the amount of \$274,278.68, utilizing a single source exemption, with an additional approval of a \$15,000 contingency, with funding to be provided by the Capital Projects Multi-Year Fund. (D. Smith)
BACKGROUND:	Glynn County, per an agreement with GDOT, is responsible for the maintenance and operation of High Mast lighting located at the four I-95 interchanges in Glynn County, including Exit 42, the interchange of I-95 and Hwy 99, both of which are GDOT rights of way. The current lighting is obsolete and the light heads and parts are no longer being supported due to the phasing out of this type of lighting for more efficient LED bulbs and heads. This project will convert all lighting associated with the interchange (High Mast Lights and Wall Pak Lighting) to LED. The contract for this work and the agreement to do so is with Georgia Power and all work will be completed by Georgia Power. Georgia Power has deigned the project to meet GDOT roadway lighting standards as is required per the existing GDOT agreement. The design work is included in the service with Georgia Power,

eliminating the need for a separate firm to design and permit. Glynn County, per the GDOT agreement, is responsible for the cost of electrical power for this interchange. It is anticipated that Glynn County will be replacing the High Mast and Wall Pak Lighting at the remaining three interchanges in future years.
