Summary Background:

The motion, as drafted, provides City staff with authorization to proceed and enables staff to prepare cost proposals to perform the services required within the scope of work.

The Council at the November 6, 2017 meeting amended the FY18 Capital Budget to add the Hyatt Park Placemaking Project and reallocated \$325,000 in CIP funding for this project.

The City Council will need to accept the project design and provide authorization to proceed.

Finally, under the terms of the existing Joint-Use Agreement between the City and the Maryland-National Capital Park & Planning (M-NCPPC), M-NCPPC requires a letter from the City requesting an amendment to the Joint Use Agreement, authorizing the City to proceed with the proposed improvements.

Next Steps:

Staff will prepare contracts for consideration by the Council at the May 21. 2018 meeting.
