SUBJECT

The Mayor and City Council will hold a public hearing on the 2017 Election Advisory Referendum Question on Monday, April 17 at 7:30 p.m. (prior to the City Council Meeting).

The City Council has requested the input of residents on the size and composition of the Council. It is an advisory, non-binding referendum that will request your opinion on the total number of Council Members, the number of wards and Council Members elected per ward, and whether there should be any Council Members elected at-large by all voters of the City.

The Hyattsville City Council is currently composed of ten (10) Council Members and one (1) Mayor elected at-large. The City is composed of five (5) wards with two (2) Council Members elected per ward.

A copy of the referendum resolution adopted by the Council is included in the Agenda Packet for the Public Hearing.

The Public Hearing will be held at the City Municipal Building, 4310 Gallatin Street, in the third floor Council Chambers. The Public Hearing will be broadcast live on Comcast Channel 71, Verizon Channel 12 and online at www.hyattsville.org/meetings.
