Summary Background:

In May 2017 the Mayor and City Council approved the City staff to proceed with the design and renovation of 3505 Hamilton Street to be the new Hyattsville City Police Station. As part of the design process, the Project Manager issued a Request for Proposal in April 2018 for the required Environmental Remediation of the building. Proposals were received on May 11, 2018. Upon review of the proposals received, Retro Environmental, Inc. was chosen as the most responsive and responsible option and determined to be the best value for the City.
