Executive Summary:

The 2023 Park Renovations Project includes playground, shelter, and restroom replacements, as well as sidewalk and accessibility improvements located at Kiwanis, Hunter's Run, Happy Hollow, and Hickory Hill Parks. The Project Manual was approved at the February 21, 2023 Council Meeting, and the engineer's estimated cost of construction was \$865,000, which includes the cost of the base bid and Alternate #1.

Three (3) bids were submitted prior to the March 15, 2023 deadline:

In accordance with City policy, the low bidder is determined by the base bid amount without alternates. Public Works and Engineering recommend awarding the project to All American Concrete of West Liberty, Iowa in the amount of \$828,288, which includes the base bid and Alternate #1.

Background / Analysis:

Kiwanis, Hunter's Run, Happy Hollow, and Hickory Hill parks are all prioritized in the 2017 Park Master Plan due to the age and condition of their current structures. This project includes playground replacement at Kiwanis Park, playground replacement at Hunter's Run Park, demolition of the current playground and preparations for City Staff to install new playground equipment outside of this project at Happy Hollow Park, and restroom and shelter replacement at the Conklin Lane entrance of Hickory Hill Park. Playground and shelter selections were based on various public meetings and surveys.

Project Timeline: Construction – April to October 2023
