Executive Summary:

This is a resolution to continue the joint funding agreement with Johnson County Social Services for the Mobility Coordinator position. The Mobility Coordinator provides transportation and mobility referrals, education, and community outreach in Iowa City and across the metro area.

Background / Analysis:

The Mobility Coordinator's goals are to increase awareness of the metro area public transit system and improve mobility for the elderly, low-income, persons with disability or medical issues, and the mobility challenged.

The Mobility Coordinator helps residents reach their destinations by providing information on community transportation options, offering trip planning and education, and transit system training.

The position is jointly funded by Johnson County (50%), Iowa City (35%), and Coralville (15%). The total costs of the position including salary, benefits, supplies, and mileage are divided amongst the three entities. Iowa City's total contribution in FY25 is \$41,196.
