Executive Summary:

This agenda item begins the bidding process for the construction of the 2023 Wastewater Roof Improvements Project.

Background / Analysis:

A multi-year roof management program was prepared in December 2022 to assist the Wastewater Division with maximizing the life of the roofing systems on all buildings at the Wastewater Treatment Facility and stormwater and sanitary lift stations throughout the City.

This project includes complete tear-off and roof replacements on the Gas Metering Building, Sludge Processing Building and South McCollister Pump Station. Additionally, miscellaneous repairs will be completed on the Influent Pump Station, Grit Dewatering Building, Blower Building, and Sludge Pump Building.
