Executive Summary:

This agenda item awards the Kirkwood Avenue CRANDIC Railroad Project. Four (4) bids were submitted prior to the May 9, 2024 deadline:

Staff recommends awarding the contract for the Kirkwood Avenue CRANDIC Railroad Crossing Project to Feldman Concrete.

Background / Analysis:

CRANDIC Railroad is repairing the railroad crossing on Kirkwood Avenue and is working with the City to construct the approaches to the crossing. This project generally includes removal and replacement of pavement, ADA compliant sidewalk and curb ramps, and storm intake tops replacement.

Final Completion – September 2024
