SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing execution of a first amendment to the agreement with DC Electric Group, Inc. for on call streetlight and traffic signal maintenance and repair services, increasing the total not-to-exceed amount from \$700,000 to \$1,500,000 and extending the term of the agreement two additional years to June 30, 2028.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a first amendment to the agreement with DC Electric Group, Inc. (DC Electric) for on call streetlight and traffic signal maintenance services to increase the total not-to-exceed amount from \$700,000 to \$1,500,000 and extend the term of the agreement two additional years to June 30, 2028.

SUMMARY

The Maintenance Division of the Public Works Department utilizes a combination of contract services and City staff to perform streetlight and traffic signal maintenance throughout the City. The current agreement with DC Electric for on call streetlight and traffic signal maintenance allows for an extension of the term of the agreement with one optional two-year extension. The proposed amendment will provide the necessary support needed to maintain streetlights and traffic signals to the standard desired by the City.

DISCUSSION

The Maintenance Division of the Public Works Department is tasked with maintaining, repairing, and replacing over 7,500 streetlights and 115 traffic signals throughout the City.

On June 26, 2023, City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a general services agreement with DC Electric in the amount of \$700,000 to provide on call streetlight and traffic signal maintenance throughout the City.

The first amendment modifies the hourly rates for services, increases the total compensation of the not-to-exceed amount to \$1,500,000 and extends the term of the agreement to June 30, 2028.

FISCAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACTS

Funding for this agreement is currently budgeted in the Signals and Streetlights FY 2026-27 General Fund budget. Additional appropriations will be included in the FY 2026-27 budget update as necessary.


